How to enter

The competition is split into three stages. Throughout, EY professionals will be looking for evidence of problem-solving skills, commercial awareness and critical thinking – as well as the practical skills that will mark you out as one of the best.

Stage 1: Regional competition

Submit an application, outlining your motivations for entering the competition and answer a couple of questions that will help us get to know you more. If selected, you will attend the regional competition in your location.

If you do well at the regional, you may be rewarded with a trip to Sydney to compete in the Oceania country competition.

If you are selected to progress to the Oceania final, you will receive an internship in an EY Tax team.

Stage 2: Oceania competition

As a regional winner, you will compete in the Oceania competition where you will participate in individual and group activities. The top three finalists will receive a cash prize. The overall winner will also represent Oceania in the global competition and receive a future graduate position with EY Oceania Tax.

Stage 3: Global competition

As the Oceania winner, you will participate in the EY Young Tax Professional of the Year (YTPY) Global competition, taking place overseas in early 2025. Global finalists will work closely with people from other cultures and backgrounds from across the world, and be challenged with individual and group activities in front of EY leaders, client and academia judges.
